



INTRODUCING TINYCAT – THE NEW ONLINE CATALOGUE FOR THE PASA LIBRARY

TinyCat is simple to use, powerful, cost effective, and entirely web-based. It will show the latest catalogue information and you can now search from your home computer!

Basic Search:

- Click on the TinyCat logo from the Pasa home page.
- Use the search bar on the Pasa library homepage (see blue arrow above) to search for any title, author, tag, subject, publication date, etc. You can enter any text!
- It is also possible to browse by "Subject", just click on blue links directly below the Basic Search bar.
- TinyCat will show all matches for your search, sorted by relevancy (by default). Use the sort drop-down menu, on the right of the page, to sort your searches by acquisition, title, publication date, author, or popularity

Advanced Search:

- Advanced Search is found by clicking the down arrow icon to the right of the Basic Search bar (see red arrow above). Search for any field, or fields, using AND/OR logic. You can even limit your search by Collection, Language, and/or Media type.
